Partnership Grant Guidelines

To be eligible to submit a Letter of Intent (LOI), your organization must be a governmental entity, an educational institution, or a 501(c)(3) nonprofit that has held tax-exempt status for five (5) years or more as of the year you submit your LOI. Additionally, the program/project must serve northern Nevada.

You are invited to complete this application if your organization meets the minimum criteria. LOIs must be submitted no later than 12 p.m. on June 1, 2017. The link will be closed after that time.

If your organization is invited to submit a full proposal, those proposals will be due via an online application no later than 12 p.m. on August 15, 2017. You will receive the link and a password in your invitation to apply. The selection committee will review these proposals and select those recommended for funding. Applicants may request up to \$15,000.

This grant is available for single year funding. However, since the Community Foundation has made evaluation our mission for the next 2 years, you are encouraged to reapply.

The Partnership grants committee will meet in September 2017 and decisions will be communicated shortly thereafter.
