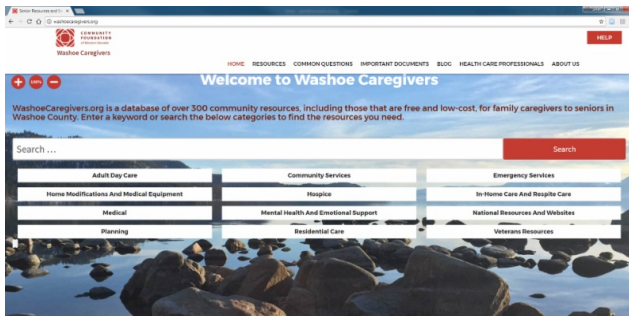
#### Requests for Proposals Open until February 8, 2019

[The Truckee River Fund](#) and the [Nevada Dream Tags Fund](#) are offering open requests for proposals. The Dream Tags Charitable Fund provides funding to engage Nevadans in wildlife conservation by focusing donated funds



to restore resilience in at-risk Nevada habitats with projects that support the preservation, protection, management, or restoration of wildlife and its habitat. The Truckee River Fund makes grants for projects that protect and enhance water quality or water resources of the Truckee River and its watershed. A 25% match is required for requested funding from both RFPs.
