Community Needs and COVID-19 Responses: Arts and Culture Organizations

Artist's Co-op of Reno

We have had to close our doors and cancel all receptions and fundraisers. We service customers by appointment only. We usually offer fundraising shows for other nonprofit organizations. All are cancelled now

We need to pay our ongoing expenses of about \$1500 per month plus we have had plans to renew our heating and air conditioning for \$21000. The heating units are about 50 years old and at risk of dangerously going down.

Arts for All Nevada

Started posting free art activities, weekly, on our website; moved some classes to Zoom (remote learning). Working with JTNN's Wellness Wednesdays teaching meditative drawing. Working with Washoe County School District to create video art workshops, that meet academic standards, for special needs students. Developed 2 Summer Art Camp at Home kits: each contain 7 visual arts and 1 creative movement activities. Includes all needed art supplies, written, and video-taped lessons.

Immediate needs: funds to convert to programming on-line. Funding of a Lake Mansion virtual reality tour. We have lost all rental income, \$20,000, which funds Lake Mansion maintenance/general operating.

Future needs: Plans to convert, reconfigure, and grow public programming and free festivals on line or in smaller groups. Make up lost revenue from cancellation of Art Adventures, afterschool art program. Conversion of public art classes/camps to remote learning, home kits or, limited enrollment, on-site classes. Limited class sizes and remote programming cuts revenue and limits general operating. Staff continues to create programming and maintain the Lake Mansion (a fixed expense), with a decrease in programming and rental revenue. New funding sources need to be found or we see a reduction in operations by at least \$50,000-\$100,000.
